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Understanding the CRPO Exam

The College of Registered Psychotherapists of Ontario (CRPO) Registration Exam assesses whether candidates meet entry-to-practice competencies across ethics, clinical judgment, cultural responsiveness, documentation, and professional conduct. Successful completion helps candidates remove the “Qualifying” designation and progress to independent practice (subject to all other CRPO requirements).

The exam is computer-based and consists of multiple-choice and scenario-driven questions. Candidates read client vignettes and respond to questions that may require selecting a single best answer or choosing multiple appropriate responses. Each option is pre-scored along a continuum from most helpful to most harmful. The goal is to select responses that demonstrate sound clinical judgment while avoiding those that could be harmful.

What can you expect going into the exam?

The CRPO Registration Exam is designed to assess how you think, reason, and respond as a professional psychotherapist.

It evaluates your ability to apply knowledge ethically and effectively, not how much you can memorize. The points below will help you understand the nature of the exam and how to approach it with confidence.



1. It's About Application, Not Memorization

The exam measures your ability to apply the CRPO competencies in practical scenarios.

Rather than recalling definitions or theoretical details, you'll need to demonstrate sound judgment, ethical reasoning, and client-centred thinking.

Focus on understanding how to use your knowledge in context.

What decision would best reflect safe, effective, and professional practice?

2. There Isn't Always One Perfect Answer

Many questions describe situations where more than one option could seem correct.

Your task is to choose the most appropriate and least harmful response.

The exam tests how you balance ethics, client safety, and professional responsibility, much like real-world clinical reasoning.
